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



SABA LOBBY DAY

Since 2017, SABA has conducted a Lobby Day that brings SABA attorneys to Washington, D.C., (whether virtually or in-person¹) to meet with Congressional offices and discuss issues of advocacy that are most important to SABA Members and our community. During Lobby Day, SABA Members will participate in advocacy meetings in Spring, 2022². SABA LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE

Launched in 2021, the SABA Leadership Institute ("SLI") is an innovative leadership program designed to "mind the gap" in leadership development for mid-career attorneys.

SLI brings together a fellowship class of diverse attorneys with 10-15 years of experience. Over a period of eight months, these fellows learn from each other, seasoned SABA attorney mentors, and experts in the field. The program provides tools, resources and education that will allow these fellows to excel in their careers, lead SABA, and serve in their communities.

The inaugural class of the SLI included fellows from 11 states and provinces across North America. They practice in a variety of legal and policy areas and represent small and large law firms, the government, and for-profit and not-for-profit organizations.

Our first class just completed its program, and the response of the alumni has been overwhelmingly positive!

In January 2022, SABA will begin the second class of this program.

As we continue to build and expand SLI, it presents a unique opportunity to access and develop professional relationships with future leaders within the South Asian bar and communities across North America. It also allows our Sponsors to demonstrate support for diversity and inclusion in the legal profession.


SABA VIRTUAL PROGRAMMING

You Qualify If You:

1

Are at least 18 years old

Lived in the U.S. as a green card holder for more than 5 years (3 years if married to U.S. citizen)

Have been physically present in the U.S. for more than 2 .5 years (18 months if married to U.S. citizen)

Can show you have good moral character

Can speak, read and write basic English

Can pass a test on the U.S. government and American history

NOVEMBER 16, 2019

In 2018, over **200** people completed their naturalization applications.

Another 100 were able to get more information on the process, eligibility and reasons to become a U.S. citizen.
